Ownership of equipment will be transferred to Northwest Ohio Bomb Squad, hosted by Toledo Police. FY2019 State Homeland Security Program grant funds will be utilized for 100% of this purchase.

Section 2. The Deputy Director of Purchasing is hereby directed to issue a Purchase Order to Logos Imaging, LLC.


