Title: Award of Contract to A & A Safety, Inc. of Amelia, Ohio for the LUC – CR 95 7.4 – Monclova Crosswalks, PID #117152

Summary/Background: On October 4, 2022, by Resolution No. 22-877, the Board approved the plans, specifications and cost estimate and granted permission to advertise for bids for the LUC – CR 95 7.4 – Monclova Crosswalks, PID #117152. A bid opening was held on February 16, 2023 and the following bids were received:
